

SLANT

The SLANT strategy is a strategy to help you pay attention in class.

S—Sit up straight

L—Lean forward

A—Ask questions if you do not understand

N—Nod your head to show you understand

T—Track the teacher with your eyes

The SLANT strategy is a strategy that you should use everyday in all of your classes. It is not enough to just show up to class and do the assignments. You need to attend your classes and pay attention.

If you are following the SLANT strategy correctly you will hear all the important information that your teachers cover in class, which could include notes, test information, assignments, due dates, directions, etc.

It is very important to participate in your classes and show your teachers that you are paying attention. The SLANT strategy will help you with that. It is also very important to ask your teachers questions when you don't understand something. How will they know that you don't understand something if you don't ask questions?

The SLANT strategy is essential in helping you pay attention and participate in your classes. The SLANT strategy will help you have more success in school. Keep in mind, the SLANT strategy is easy to remember, but it doesn't do you any good just to know it, you need to use it!
